KC/ACTF will once again host summer stock acting auditions and design/tech interviews exclusively for our participants. Audition and interview times will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis starting on Tuesday, January 18 (same time and same place as the Ryan Check-In).

- \*Auditions will start at 10:00 AM on Wednesday, January 19. Auditioners are asked to prepare a 90 second audition, strictly timed. The 90 seconds includes an introduction and singing. An accompanist will be provided, so bring your sheet music. Dance auditions will follow the general audition at a time to be announced (based on the number of auditions). Callbacks will begin immediately after auditions. Bring resumes and pix.
- \*Technical interviews will be held in the afternoon. Bring resumes and portfolio materials as appropriate to your expertise.

#### Please note:

Companies are producing musical theater this summer in addition to their regular plays, so, please, keep your audition choices light, though not necessarily contemporary. (Some companies produce the classics.) Last year, several contracts were awarded as a direct result of this audition and interview process. A full list of the participating companies will be announced prior to the Festival. To date- Theatre L'Homme Dieu in St. Cloud Minnesota; Highland Summer Theatre in Mankato, Minnesota; Horsefeathers and Applesauce in Winfield, Kansas are on board.
